

Rowdy Rooster Racing, Daniels Performance and RacePro Motorsports make World Speed Record Attempt at the Bonneville Salt Flats.

Rowdy Rooster Racing in addition to its ongoing collaboration with Daniels's Performance is proud to welcome a new partnership with Rob Hassay and the RacePro Motorsports Family in its 2009 attempt to break an AMA Speed Record. The attempt will be made during the Bub's International Speed Trials at the World Famous Bonneville Salt Flats. Owner Jim Freeman and Crew Chief Mike Daniels are happy to bring Rob Hassay onboard to ride the "Rooster" in its attempt for a record in the MPS PF class. If successful in breaking the current record of 153 and change, set by Laura Klock and the Klockwerks Team during the Trials in 2008, will give the partnership claim to the "Unofficial" title of "World's Fastest Bagger," currently owned by Brian Klock.

The machine, a 2003 Harley-Davidson Road King FLHRI was brought to the Salt Flats last year in pieces and was only run three times on the last half day of the event. Even with the limited time and Jim's large 280 lb frame the bike easily went in excess of 140 mph.

According to Daniels and Freeman, "bringing Rob into the mix as our rider makes all the sense in the world. His years of Grand National dirt track racing experience give him a comfort level at high speeds on a constantly changing surface. The big bonus is his flyweight and the fact that when Rob is tucked-in he provides not little, but NO frontal area. This eliminates drag and will make the bike much more stable at close to 160, which we fully intend to run."

Hassay is confident that the Daniels/Freeman machine is up to the task," Mike is one of the foremost engine tuners in the country, and we have called on his expertise for our ProTour customers many times over the years. Mike will be able to squeeze every ounce of performance possible from Jim's bagger. All I have to do is sit (lay) there for several miles and let the bike do its thing!" Rob was quick to add that he'll just have to remember not to pitch it sideways, or back it in at the one mile mark!"
